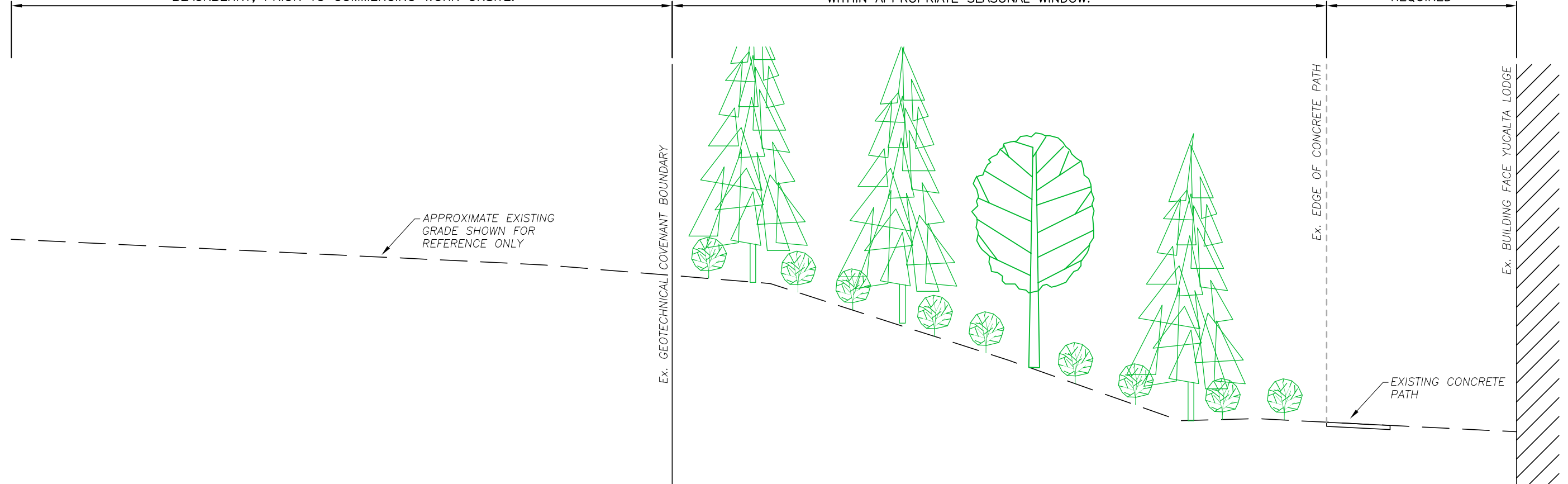


USABLE AREA FOR HOSPITAL CONSTRUCTION TO BE CLEARED OF ANY NOXIOUS WEEDS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO KNOTWEED, SCOTCHBROOM AND HIMALAYAN BLACKBERRY, PRIOR TO COMMENCING WORK ONSITE.

VARIES (APPROXIMATELY 15–20m WIDE). LANDSCAPE TREATMENT PER NOTES BELOW. BUFFER TO BE PLANTED PRIOR TO, OR UPON COMMENCEMENT OF, WORK ONSITE WITHIN APPROPRIATE SEASONAL WINDOW.

NOTES:

1. UPON REMOVAL OF NOXIOUS WEEDS, AREA TO BE TREATED WITH:
 - 1.1. MINIMUM 300mm THICKNESS GROWING MEDIUM
 - 1.2. MINIMUM 75mm THICKNESS HEM/FIR MULCH
 - 1.3. ALL PLANTS TO BE NATIVE (I.E. LISTED IN "POJAR AND MCKINNON")
 - 1.4. EVERY 25m² TO BE PLANTED WITH:
 - 1.4.1. 3–3m TALL CONIFEROUS TREES
 - 1.4.2. 5–2m TALL CONIFEROUS TREES
 - 1.4.3. 7–1m TALL CONIFEROUS TREES
 - 1.4.4. 3–2m TALL DECIDUOUS TREES
 - 1.4.5. 7–#5 POT SHRUBS
 - 1.4.6. NO SINGLE PLANT SPECIES TO COMPRISE MORE THAN 30% OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PLANTS
- 1.5. TEMPORARY IRRIGATION SYSTEM TO BE SUSTAINED FOR A MINIMUM OF 3 YEARS FOLLOWING INSTALLATION
- 1.6. BUFFER TO BE MAINTAINED TO "LEVEL 2" STANDARD PER BC LANDSCAPE STANDARDS BY BCSLA/BCNTA. BUFFERS TO BE KEPT FREE OF NOXIOUS WEEDS.
