PROPONENT WITHDRAWS FROM KICKING HORSE CANYON PROJECT – PHASE 2

The SNC Lavalin team, one of three qualified teams that were issued the Requests for Proposals for Phase 2 of the Kicking Horse Canyon project, has notified Partnerships BC that it has withdrawn from the competition. Phase 2 of the Kicking Horse Canyon project involves improvements to a section of the Trans Canada Highway between Golden, BC and Yoho National Park.

SNC Lavalin confirmed that, while the Kicking Horse Canyon project is an attractive opportunity, other commitments at this time preclude the team from continued involvement in the competitive process.

The two remaining teams, the KHC Highway Group and the Trans-Park Highway Group, are working towards submitting their proposals for the project this summer. The teams include the following members:
